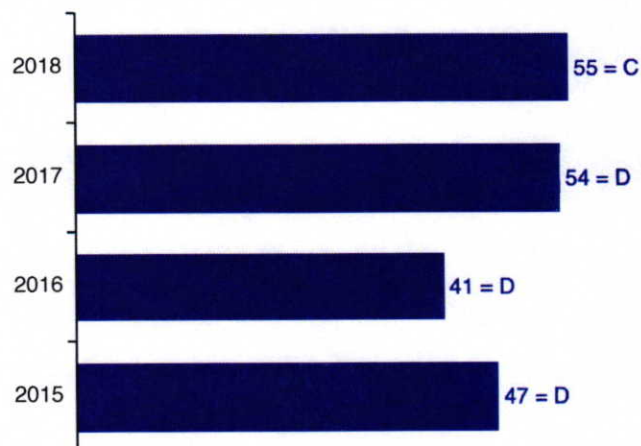

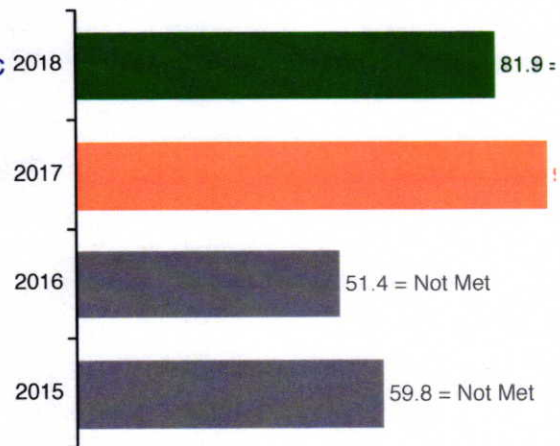

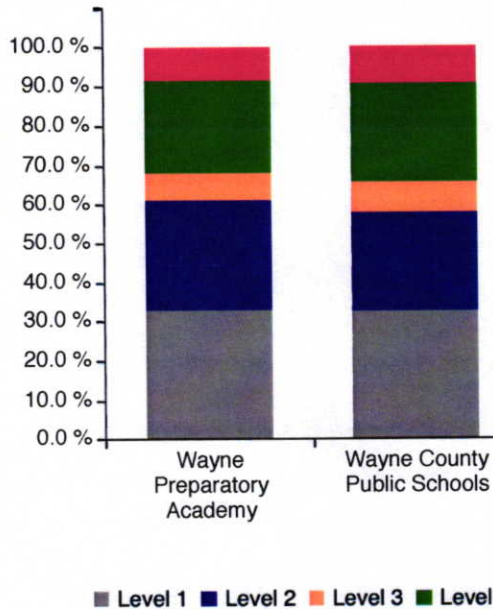

Proficiency in Subject Areas

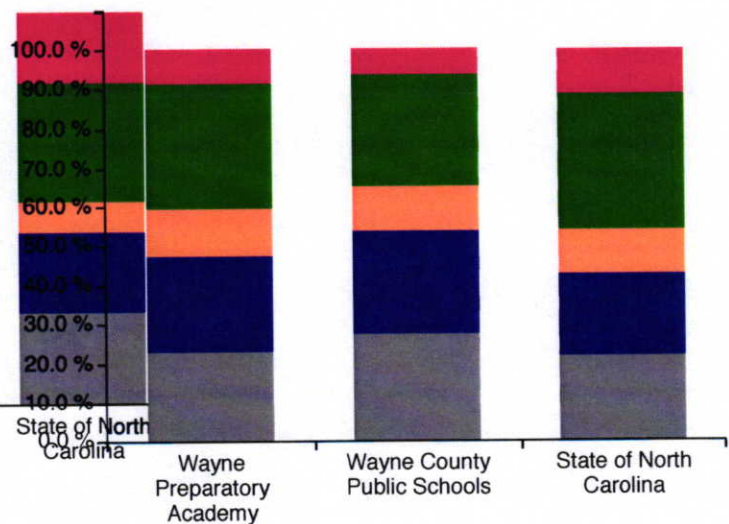

Percentage of students participating in state mandated standardized testing.

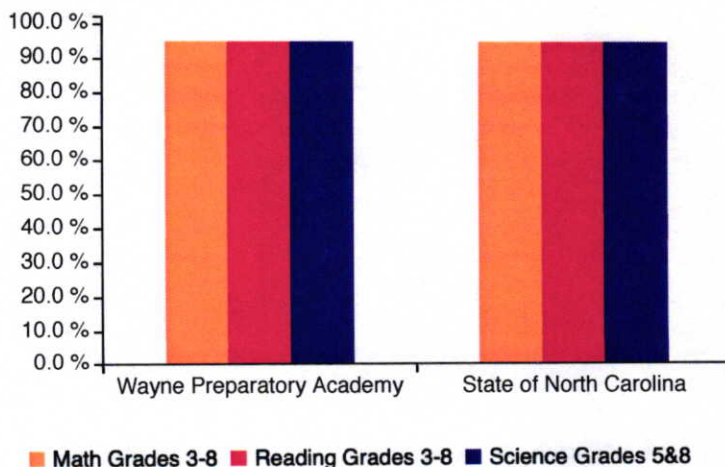


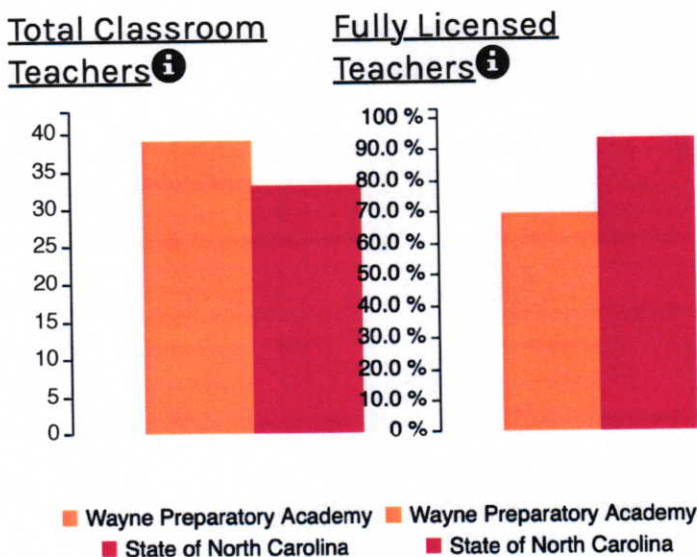

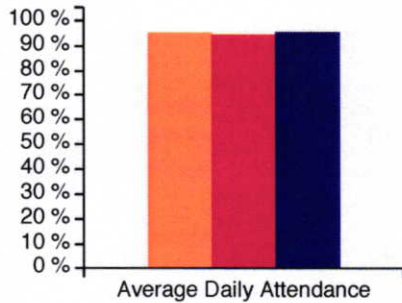

Suspension and Expulsion Rates (per 1000 students) ⁱ

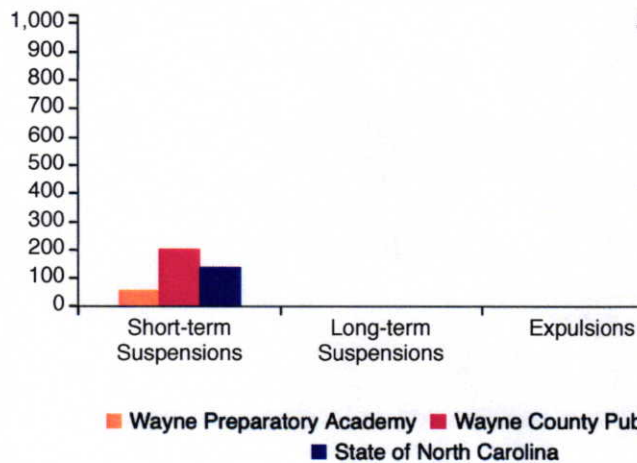

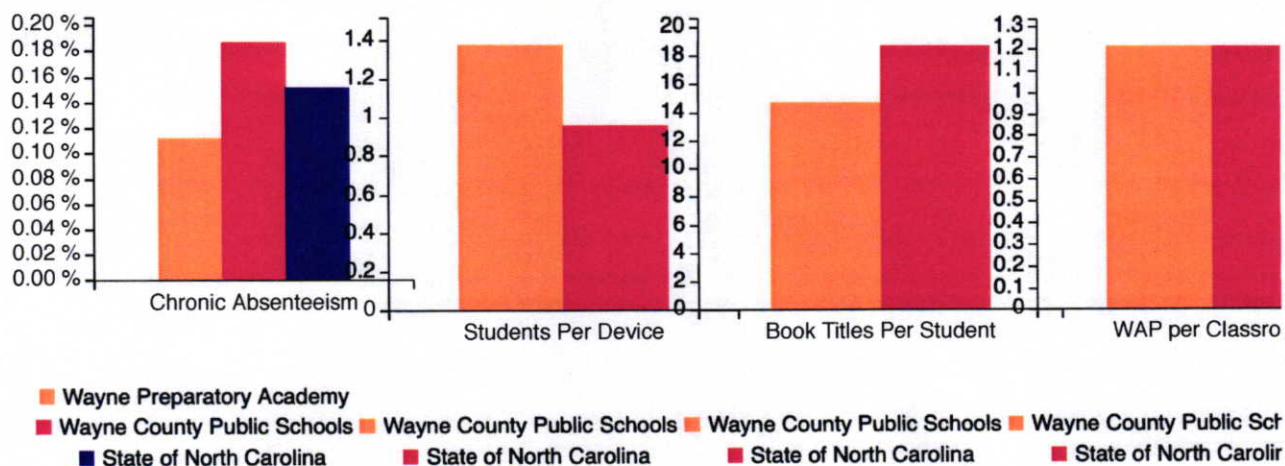

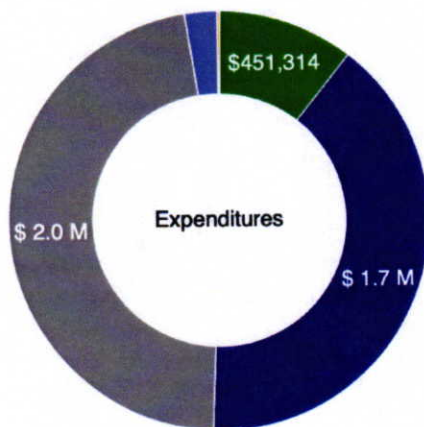
